Degree Level Courses

19+ year old Academy students can study a 2 year Foundation Degree and then 'TopUp' to a full BSc (Hons) Degree in Sports Science in their 3rd year.

The Foundation degree (FdSc) and 'TopUp' Degree allow students to follow one of three specialist pathways these being Sports Coaching, Strength and Conditioning or Performance Analysis. You will be able to further tailor your degree during your final year through your research and work experience modules.

Both the FdSc and BSc are validated by the University of East Anglia (UEA), who are consistently rated as one of the top 20 universities in the country (14th in 2017 The Complete University Guide).
