Placement Purpose:

To assist in providing aspects of sports medicine care to Leicester Tigers Senior and Academy Players.

Main Tasks & Responsibilities:

 Ability to perform treatment and rehabilitation under the direction and supervision of a Senior/Academy Physiotherapist/Sports Therapist.

- Liaise with the Medical Lead and other medical team members regarding the assessment, progress and ongoing treatment of players.
- Assist the Senior and Academy Physiotherapist/Sports Therapist with the organisation of player testing.
- Ensure the recovery systems for players are organised daily hot / cold baths and sauna.
- Ensure the recovery equipment is organised and available for use daily gameready, compex etc.
- Be trained and updated in acute pitch side care, including spinal injury and cardiopulmonary resuscitation, in your capacity as a member of the Leicester Tigers Medical Team.
- Weekly match day preparation (organise equipment, pack/stock medical bag).
- Ensure the medical room is organised to an acceptable level.
- Keep up to date on recent research in sports physiotherapy and rugby related physiotherapy issues.
- Maintain and update your knowledge and practice of sports medicine, to include participation in Leicester Tigers performance team CPD.
- Carry out any other duties that may be assigned from time to time and are within the post holders capacities.
